## **Carl Rosso**

JUL 5, 1932 - JAN 15, 2013

**C**arl Rosso, age 80, of Lorain passed away Tuesday, January 15, 2013 at Autumn Aegis Nursing Home.

Carl was born on July 5, 1932 in Lorain, Ohio to Joseph and Lena (nee Temerario) Rosso. He was a graduate of Lorain High School. He enlisted with the United States Navy on May 2, 1951 and served his country for a period during the Korean War. While enlisted he received the National Defense Service Medal and the Good Conduct Medal. He was honorably discharged on April 6, 1955.

He was employed by Columbia Gas, retiring in 1998 at the age of 65. He was a lifelong member of the Church of St. Peter, Lorain. Carl enjoyed roller skating and gambling. He had a passion for genealogy, discovering and preserving his family's history. A talented craftsman he enjoyed woodworking, creating numerous furniture pieces. Carl was a wonderful and giving man, always there to help out his family and friends.

Carl is survived by his wife of 56 years, Pauline (nee Cote) sons, Donald (Marilyn) Rosso, of Amherst and Joseph (Angela) Rosso, of Avon; daughters, Gloria (Steve) Maxwell, of Lorain and Denise (David Adams) Rosso, of Oberlin; grandchildren, Jerry Harkless, Rachel Merry, Carl (Kara) Rosso, Pamela Merry and Joshua Rosso; great-granddaughter, Caylee Ann Harkless.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Joseph and Lena; and siblings, Samuel Rosso, Joanne Zelnik, Tony Rosso, Carl Rosso (at age 4) and Lillian Romanski.

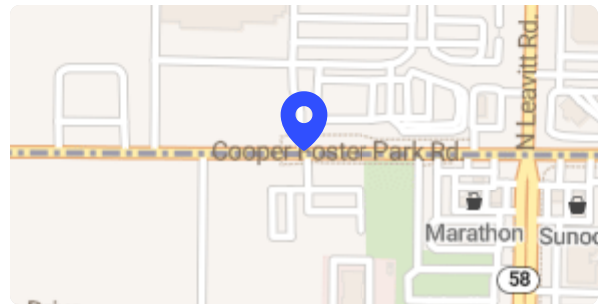

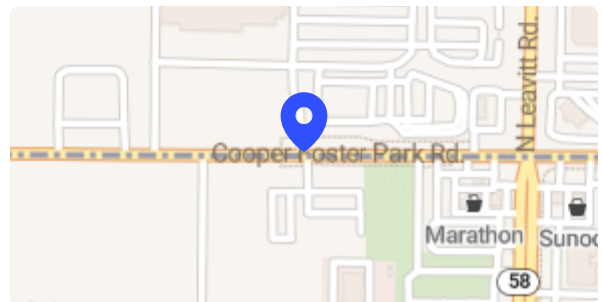

Carl and I grew up together on 13th Street. We went through Boone Elementary, Hawthorne Junior High and Lorain High School, graduating in 1950. During the Korean conflict I remember Carl coming over to my house to talk about enlisting in the Navy. Army life did not appeal to either of us. So we went to the Lorain Post Office on Broadway to the Navy Recruiting Office and enlisted together in May 1951. About 2 days after enlisting, our draft notices came in the mail. With the help of the Navy Recruiter, he took care of the notices with the local draft board. We went through Boot Camp together at the Naval Training Center at Great Lakes, Illinois. After completing our training we received orders assigning us to different naval facilities. We kept in touch occasionally seeing each other on our home leave. Both of us were discharged in April 1955. I spent the last few months of service in Long Beach, CA where my wife and I decided to return to Los Angeles to live. We have been living here since 1955. As it happens, due to our separate paths taken in our lives, Carl and I had very little contact through the years. I have very fond memories of the time Carl and I spent together during our growing years. We shared our ups and downs of our family lives and our school years. So to the entire Rosso Family, our deepest and sincerest condolences on his passing and we offer this prayer on his behalf: May Carl and all who sleep in Christ find in his presence, light, happiness and peace through Christ Our Lord. Amen
