Gregory A. Ganobcik, age 83, passed away Tuesday, December 4, 2012 at Kingston of Vermilion. He was born on November 17, 1929 in Lorain, Ohio to Emil and Agnes (nee Banacke) Ganobsek.

Greg enlisted with the United States Air Force on October 16, 1951 and was Honorably Discharged on July 28, 1955.

He was a member of St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church and a former member of Holy Trinity Parish, Lorain and St. Joseph Catholic Church, Amherst.

Greg led an adventurous life. He enjoyed hunting, being outdoors and swimming.

Extremely artistic and talented, he enjoyed painting, sketching and drawing.

Funeral arrangements are under the direction of Dovin and Reber Jones Funeral & Cremation Center.

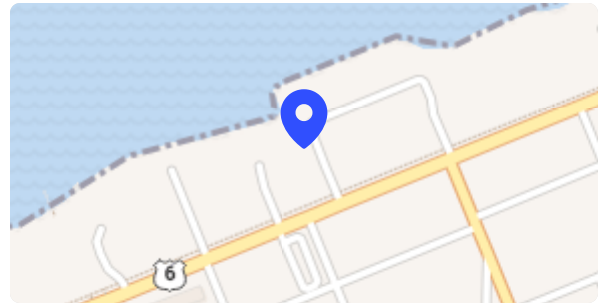

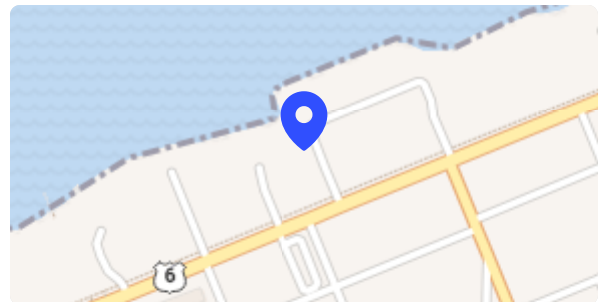
