Renna D. Stull, Jr., age 87, most recently a resident of Elms Retirement Village in Wellington, passed away suddenly on Saturday, December 15, 2012 at Mercy Regional Medical Center.

Born on February 24, 1925 in New Haven, Ohio to the late Renna and Ethel Stull, Renna lived most of his life in Willard, Ohio graduating from Willard High School. He attended and earned his Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctorate degrees from Bowling Green State University.

Renna served in the US Marines during World War II.

He spent the last 18 years living in Melbourne, Florida until moving back to the area four months ago to be by his family.

After being in the military, Renna worked at B & O Railroad. For years, he then owned and operated a business called Stull's News Center in Willard.

He began his educational career as a teacher in the Willard School System, and then served as principal at various schools within several local school districts.

Renna was preceded in death by his wife of 49 years, E. Jeanne Stull and his daughter, Deborah Stull.

He is survived by his daughter, Lisa (Greg) Shivak, of Wellington; 4 grandchildren, Derek Leasure, Jon Shivak, Sarah Mason and Renee Shivak; 10 great-grandchildren; his sister, Helen Booth, of Willard; and his companion, Donna Winkel.

The Stull Family will receive friends on Wednesday, December 19th from 3:30 p.m. until the time of memorial service at 4:00 p.m. in the Dovin and Reber Jones Funeral & Cremation Center, 1110 Cooper Foster Park Rd., Amherst. Fr. John Retar, Pastor of St. Frances Xavier Cabrini Parish in Lorain, will officiate.

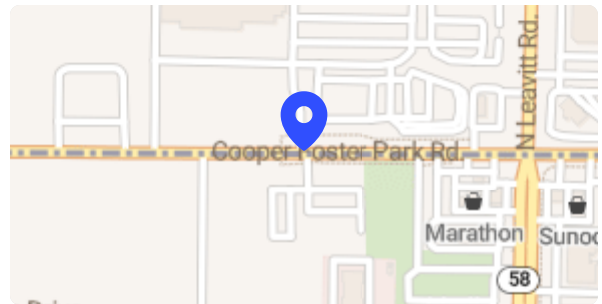

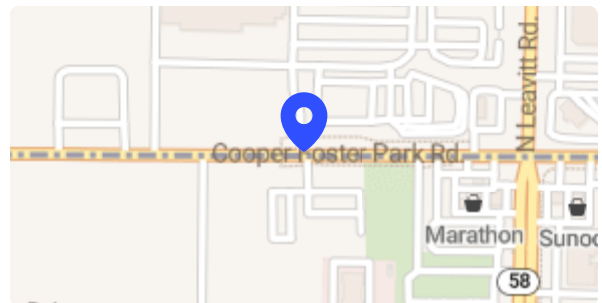
