Kathleen B. Robison, age 64, of Amherst passed away Saturday, December 1, 2012 at her home.

Upon graduation she went on to further her education, graduation from cosmetology school. On October 10, 1966 she married her sweetheart, Mark Robison. 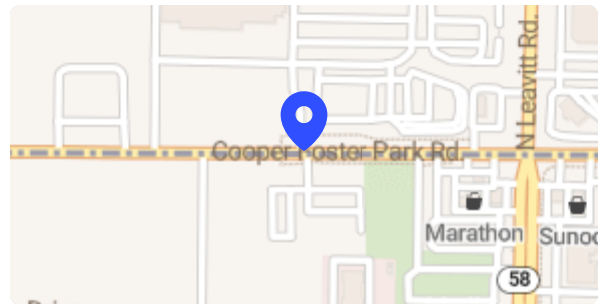

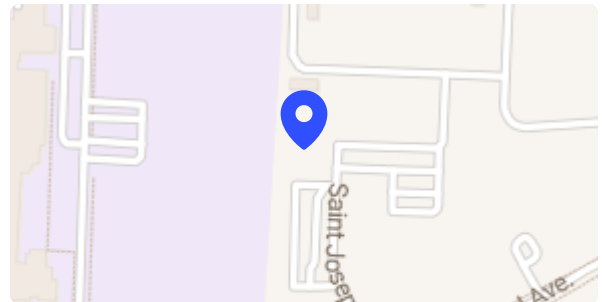

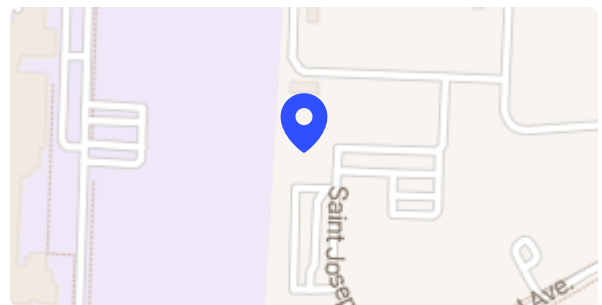
