## **Hazel Yacobozzi**

**H**azel A. Yacobozzi (nee Deidrick) passed away peacefully at her home the evening of August 25 with her her husband, Enio of 65 years at her side. An honor graduate of Amherst High School's class of 1939, Hazel was also a member of the National Honor Society and the former Knights of St. John Ladies Auxiliary Drill Team #46. She and Enio entered into the sacrament of Holy Matrimony on August 2, 1947. Enio and Hazel owned Yacobozzi Plastering, Inc. for 19 years, where she served as Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. After Enio's retirement, Hazel worked for the Lorain County Commissioners as Fiscal Officer in the Lorain County Office on Aging until 1988 when they relocated to central Ohio to be closer to their children. She was a member of St. Brendan the Navigator Roman Catholic Church, Hilliard, Ohio, St. Brendan's Seniors and Bereavement Committee and the Public Employees Retirement System.

Hazel was preceded in death by her son, Leonard Allen Yacobozzi (of Tampa, Florida), in 2009; her parents, John and Agnes Deidrick and her 5 brothers. 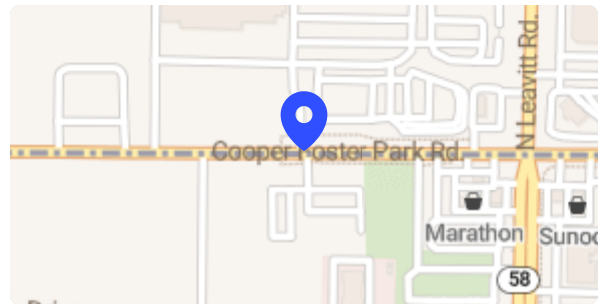

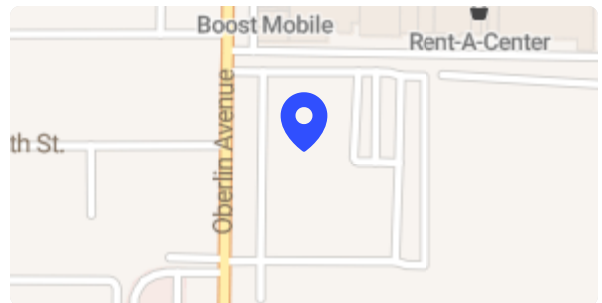
