Dorothy F. Dargo (nee Savinsky), age 73, passed away on Monday, July 2, 2012 at Mill Manor Care Center in Vermilion after a lengthy illness.

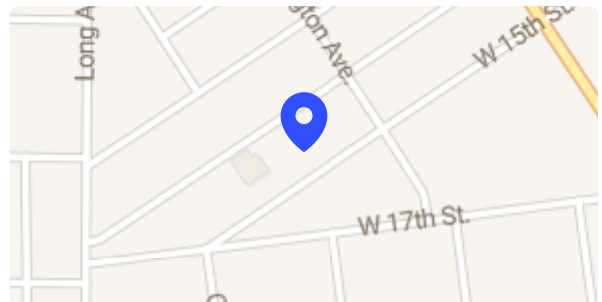
