## **Carmela Jannuzzi**

**C**armela E. “Carm” Jannuzzi, age 81, of Lorain, died on Monday, August 30, 2010 at Amherst Manor following a lengthy illness.

See was born on April 11, 1929 in Lorain to the late Pasqale and Filomena (nee Visci) DeSantis and resided in Lorain her entire life. She graduated from Lorain High School in 1947B.

Carm worked at First Federal Savings and Loan of Lorain for 12 years, retiring in 2005. She was a member of the Church of St. Peter, Lakeland Women’s Club and the Friends of the Lorain Public Library.

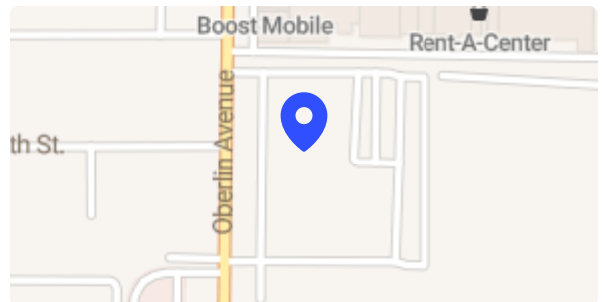
