Joseph W. Mucha, age 69, a lifelong resident of Lorain, passed away at his home on Tuesday, March 16, 2010 after a lengthy illness.

He was born on December 18, 1940 in Lorain to Walter and Sophie Mucha. He was a 1958 graduate of Lorain High School. Joseph enlisted in the United States Army on June 22, 1959. He was honorably discharged on May 31, 1965 as a Private First Class.

Joseph was employed by the Lorain City Park Department as a foreman, retiring in 1996 after 25 years of service.

He was a member of Nativity BVM Catholic Church in Lorain. Joseph enjoyed fishing and cooking. He always enjoyed tinkering with wood working and many other projects.

Joseph is survived by his wife, of 36 years, Mary Ann (nee Stauder); his son, Joseph L., of Lorain; sister, Dorothy Ehrlich, of Lake Ochechobee, Florida.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Walter and Sophie (nee Dzkielewski) Mucha and a sister, Patty Trotter.
