James E. Barnes, age 76, of Elyria, Ohio, passed away on Sunday January 3, 2010 at New Life Hospice Residential Center following a lengthy illness.

James was born on May 25, 1933 in North Ridgeville, Ohio to Charles P. and Mary (nee Darcy) Barnes.

He enlisted in The United States Army in April of 1952, as PVT-1st class, during the Korean War. He was honorably discharged on April 22, 1955, as SGT (T).

Mr. Barnes was employed as a store manager for Kroger Grocery Stores for 20 years. He then was employed in sales at Goodman Beverage for 32 years, retiring in 1998.

He was a member of the VFW Post # 1662, in Amherst. He enjoyed photography and computers.
