## **Buford "Boo" Harris,**

FEB 25, 1939 - JUN 28, 2013

**B**uford O. Harris Sr. "Boo", age 74, of Lorain passed away after a courageous battle with cancer on Friday, June 28, 2013 at his home surrounded by his family.
