## Frances Deremer

JAN 13, 1934 - MAY 2, 2013

**F**rances J. Deremer (nee Riehl), age 79, of Lorain, passed away on Thursday, May 2, 2013, peacefully in the presence of her family.

She was born on January 13, 1934 in Detroit, Michigan to the late William and Nellie (nee Britz). She graduated in 1951 from St. Anthony High School in Michigan and furthered her education at Mercy College of Detroit, graduating with her Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree in 1955.

Frances worked for 6 years as a registered nurse at Providence Hospital in Detroit. She was a member of Lakeland Women's Club and its Fine Arts Committee. She was also active with the AAUW.

Frances was a talented quilter, cross-stitcher, sewer and knitter, making many keepsakes for her family through the years. She also spent many hours studying astrology and researching her family genealogy.

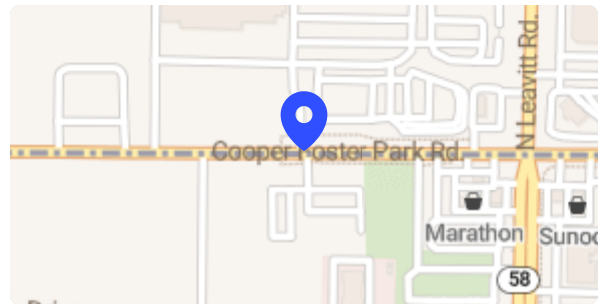

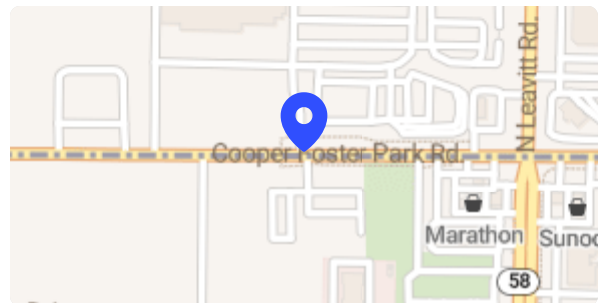
