Mildred “Millie” Elizabeth Ernst (nee Kasza), age 87, passed away at Hospice of the Valley, Phoenix, Arizona on September 24, 2013 following a long illness. Millie was born February 8, 1926 in Bay Bridge, Ohio. A long time Lorain resident, she had made her home in Sun Lakes, Arizona for the past 18 years.

Millie was a 1944 graduate of Amherst High School, where she and her twin sister, Nellie, were drum majorettes with the marching band. 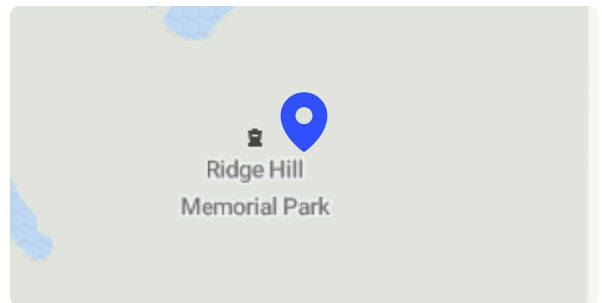
