Maria "Conchita" Carrion (nee Solis), age 86, of Lorain, passed away peacefully on Saturday, April 26, 2014 at her home, surrounded by her children.

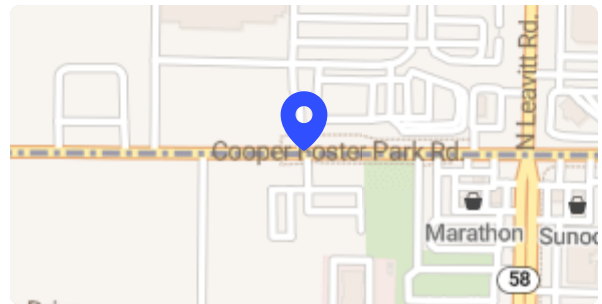

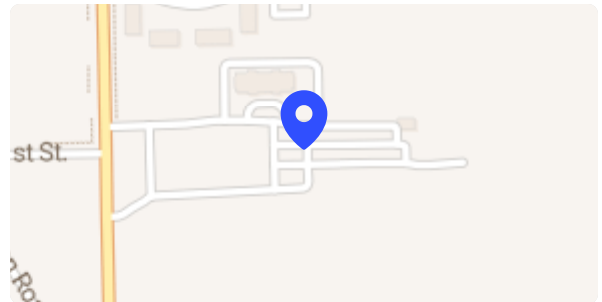

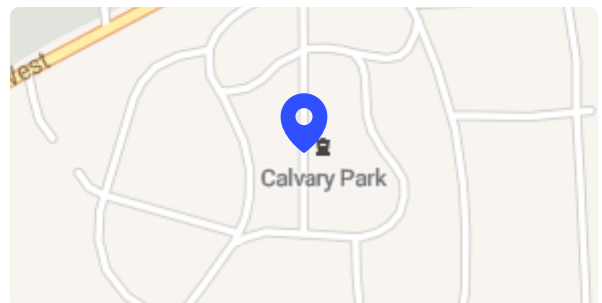
