Ann Marie Schieferstein, age 83, of Amherst passed away Tuesday, May 13, 2014 at her home after a lengthy illness.

She was born on July 30, 1930 in Lakewood, Ohio to Thomas Reed and Mary Helen (nee Moran) Hutchison. Ann worked as a cashier for the Meyer Goldberg Grocery Stores at three of their Lorain locations until their closing. She then went on to work in the coke plant for U.S. Steel. Upon leaving the steel plant she was employed as a manager for Cards and Such at Midway Mall, Elyria for 17 years, retiring in 1992. Ann was a member of St. Peter's United Church of Christ, in Amherst where she was very active, participating and chairing many of the Church's organizations. 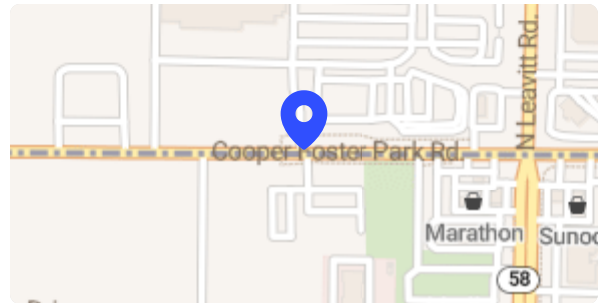
