He graduated from Lorain High School in 1935. He joined the United States Navy and served a four year term at Norfolk, VA. He received his accounting degree and began his own firm in 1950 retiring in 2013 after 53 years. He was a member of the State of Ohio CPA's. Through his work he met and made many friends and kept in touch with them even after his retirement. He was proud to have many mentors among them.

He enjoyed golfing, reading, and spending time on his computer. Up until his recent illness, Jack did most of his own cooking, especially Italian, and he did light housekeeping. Jack was a caring and generous man often sharing what he had with the needy.

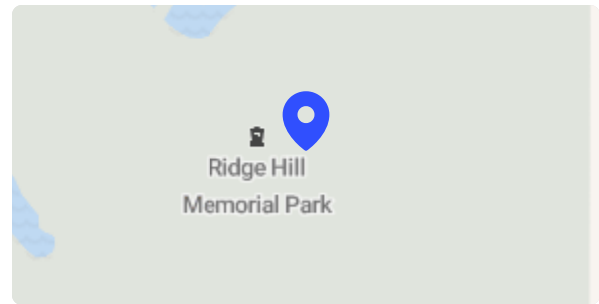
