**R**obert “Rob” Wade Johnson, age 44, of Amherst, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, March 7, 2015 at his home.

Born on May 3, 1970 in Jacksonville, Arkansas, Rob grew up in Amherst and graduated from Amherst Steele High School in 1988. He attended ITT Tech and earned two associates degrees, one in electrical engineering and the other in mechanical engineering.
