**E**leanore D. Pulgine (nee Burich), age 87, of Amherst, passed away on Monday, May 4, 2015 at New Life Hospice Center of St. Joseph.

She was born in Lorain on April 25, 1928 to the late Andrew and Anna (nee Kozarich) Burich.

For over 20 years, Eleanore worked as a monitor at all three of the Lorain City high schools, retiring in the 1980's from Southview High School.

For many years, she was an active member of the Italian American Veteran's Ladies Auxiliary, where she had served as president. Eleanore was also a member of the American Croatian Club in Lorain and Lakeland Women's Club. An avid bowler, Eleanore bowled for many years in the Ladies League at Rebman's.

She was a member of the Church of St. Peter in Lorain and the parish Senior's Group.

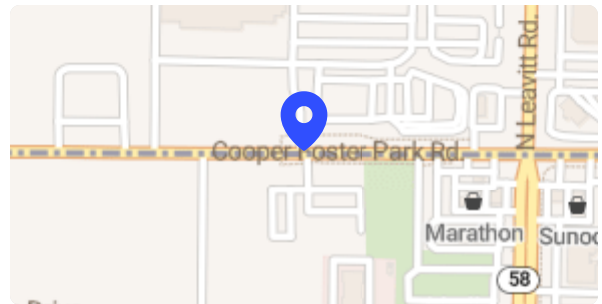

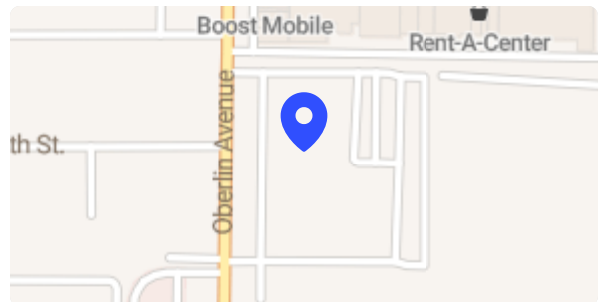

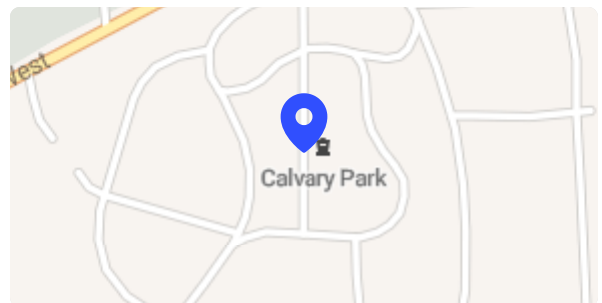
