Alexander “Alex” M. Jahnsz, age 19, of Lorain passed away on Saturday, September 22, 2018.

He was born on November 6, 1998 in Lorain, Ohio to Matthew Jahnsz and Michelle Harris Ramsey. Alex was a 2017 graduate of Marion L. Steele High School and Lorain County JVS where he studied in the HVAC program. While in high school he was a member of the wrestling team. He began wrestling at the age of 5 and received his first varsity letter as a freshman. He also played baseball with the Amherst Youth League. He always dreamed of joining the military. He had a love for the outdoors and enjoyed fishing as was quite the adventurer riding dirt bikes and BMX bikes and playing laser tag. He enjoyed looking at the constellations of the night sky and playing video games. Spending time with his family was his greatest joy and he will truly be remembered by his infectious smile.

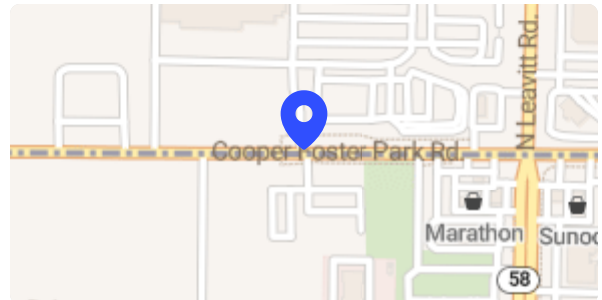
