Charles Carl Liskay, 100 of Richmond Hts., passed away January 3, 2019 under the care of Sprenger Hospice, Anchor Lodge, Lorain, Ohio. He was born Nov. 8, 1918 in New Jersey to Hungarian parents. His family moved to Cleveland for better work. He attended Parma High School then spent 4 years in the Army's 862nd Engineering Battalion and Inspector General in World War II, in the European Theater including The D-Day Battle. He received an Engineering degree from Fenn College. He met and married his wife Mary in 1948 and their 66 year marriage resulted in 4 children, 14 grandchildren, and 11 great grandchildren.

He dedicated his life to family, taking the lead from his wife Mary volunteering, gardening, and attending all the children's school and sports functioning. He kept his Hungarian spirit alive through records, radio shows, dances, parties and fine Hungarian Food. He worked in Boy Scout Troop committees, neighborhood parties, and was home every night to raise the family. He supported family in Hungary, loved his home, yard, garden, and fruit trees, and loved being around family and friends. He was a wonderful husband and father.
