Paul J. Gyeszat, Jr., age 61, of Vermilion, passed away at Mercy New Life Hospice Center of St. Joseph, on Monday, February 25, 2019, after a lengthy illness.

He was born on October 25, 1957 in New Haven, CT, but has lived most of his life in this area, graduating from Lorain Admiral King High School in 1976. After high school graduation, he went on to proudly serve his country as a combat engineer while enlisted in the United States Marine Corps from 1977 until 1979. 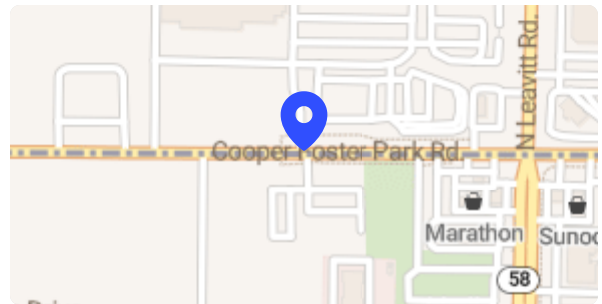

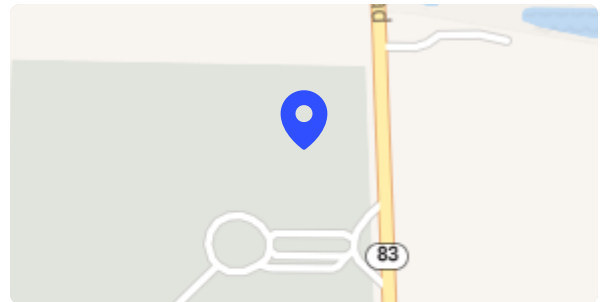

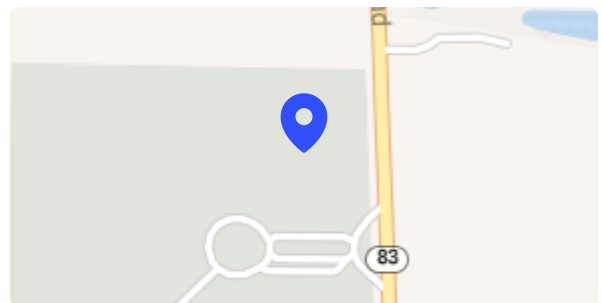
