Arthur L. “Bud” Dumke, Jr., 72, of Vermilion, passed away on Tuesday, August 13, 2019.

He was born on December 3, 1946 in Oberlin, OH, was raised in Wellington, OH, and lived most of his life in Elizabeth, New Jersey. He is a veteran of the United States Air Force and proudly served his country during the Vietnam War. Bud was a member of Disabled American Veterans, the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #2230, the American Veterans Post 22, and the Vietnam Veterans of America Group. In his years residing in New Jersey, he was employed for 32 years at P.S.E.G. in Newark, NJ, finally retiring from there in 2002.

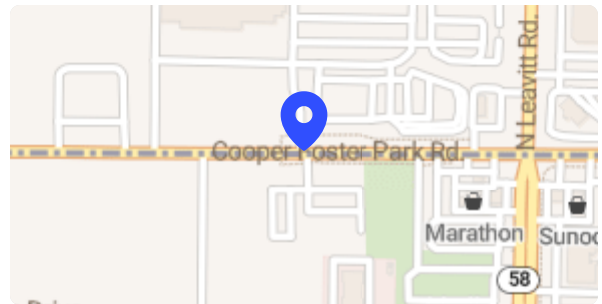

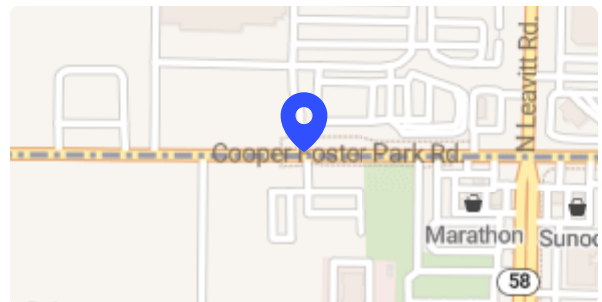

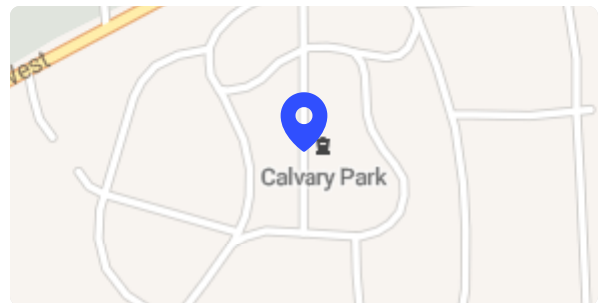
