Bert E. Mucha, age 78, of Lorain, passed away on Monday, February 3rd, 2020, at Mercy Regional Medical Center, Lorain.

He was born on July 3, 1941 in Lorain, where he lived his entire life, and is a 1960A graduate of Lorain High School. After high school graduation, he proudly served his country while enlisted in the United States Army. He was stationed in Munich, Germany before being honorably discharged in 1962.

Bert was a certified pipe welder for 22 years for American Shipbuilding. After that, he began his career as a welding instructor at Admiral King High School for 12 years and most recently, a welding instructor at Lorain County Community College, finally retiring in 2011. He is a member of the Boilermakers Union #358, where he served as President, as well as Vice President, Recording Secretary, and Union Steward.

Bert really enjoyed collecting not just stamps, but also nautical memorabilia and anything Elvis. He enjoyed being outdoors to work on his yard and was a great cook, especially when it came to barbequing.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 54 years, Marilyn M. (nee Kuznar) Mucha, his daughter, Debbie (Kevin) Jarvis, son, Jim (Lisa) Mucha, and his 2 granddaughters; Jenna Schneider and Aubry Mucha. He is also survived by his nieces and nephews. Bert was preceded in death by his parents; Joseph and Ethel (nee Kosash) Mucha and his brother, Jack.
