Robert W. Bove born on October 19, 1934, in Lorain, Ohio passed away at his home on Friday, December 24, 2021, at the age of 87.

He was a 1952 B class graduate of Lorain High School and attended LCCC. Robert served his country with the United States Army 4th Armored Division at Fort Hood, Texas, 508th. Tank Battalion.

Robert worked at National Gypsum, The Pfaudler Co., and retired from P.C. Campana, this past July 2021. He enjoyed spending time with his family, playing golf, reading, and gardening. He was a member of the Church of St. Peter where he sang in their choir, a 3rd Degree Knight with the Knights of Columbus, and a member of the Italian American Veterans Club.

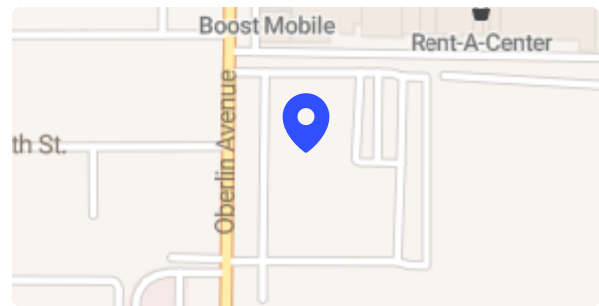

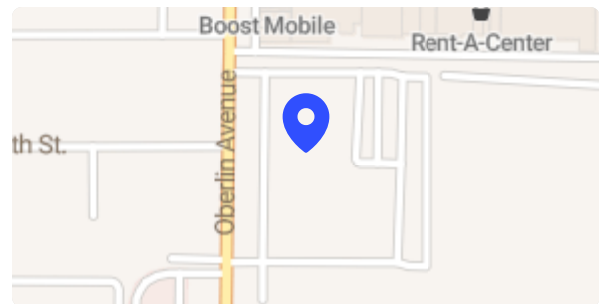
