Larry Mitoff, 74, passed away at New Life Hospice on the evening of Monday, January 1, 2024 after a courageous five year battle with cancer. Larry was born in Lorain to Shirley Mitoff (Goohs) and the late George Mitoff. He graduated from Admiral King High School and Baldwin Wallace College and spent his career as an accountant, working at TRW, KeyBank, and the City of Lorain. Larry served his country as a member of the National Guard.

Larry is survived by his loving wife of 46 years, Debbie Mitoff (Kalinowski); his son, Dan Mitoff (Alisha); daughter, Lindsey Allison (Steve); and son, Mike Mitoff (Genny); plus three grandchildren, Kennedy Mitoff, Carter Mitoff, and Zoey Mitoff. 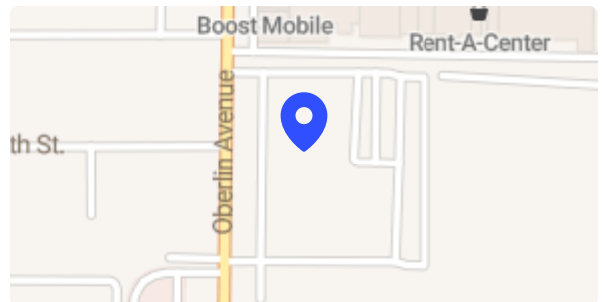

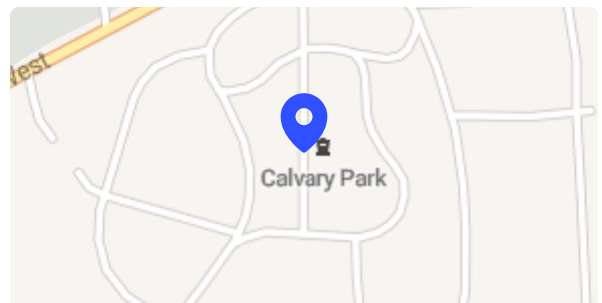
