**D**allas Ronald Tyree, age 80, of Lorain, passed away suddenly at Mercy Regional Medical Center on Monday, April 1, 2024.

He was born on May 27, 1943 in Lorain, where he lived his entire life. He graduated from Brookside High School and then furthered his education at Lorain Community College where he earned his Associates Degree. He also proudly served his country while enlisted in the United States Army, earning the rank of Sergeant before his honorable discharge. Dallas embarked on his career for the Ford Motor company for 30 years before finally retiring from there.
