Ruth Sommerville (nee Moser), age 80 of Oberlin, passed away peacefully the morning of Sunday, April 28, 2024, at her home following a lengthy illness. She was born November 24, 1943, at home in Carmichaels, Pennsylvania to Robert and Mary (nee Randolph) Moser. Ruthie or Maw, as her friends and grandchildren referred to her, was a woman of faith, raised as a Jehovah's Witness and remained a faithful servant of God throughout her life. 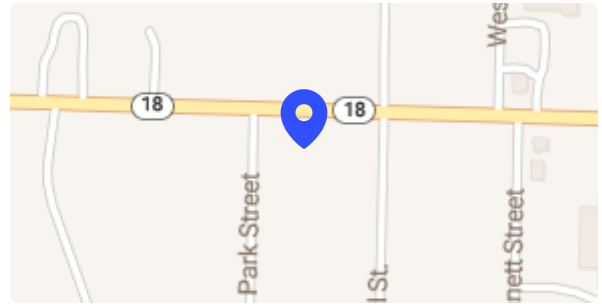
