Richard "Dick" Bogardy, passed away at home on July 26, 2024 at the age of 78. He was born Oct. 17, 1945 in Dorchester, MA. A lifelong resident of Amherst, he graduated from Marion L. Steele in 1963. He served in the United States Army from 1966-1968, where he was stationed in Germany.

He is survived by the love of his life, Janet (Kordek) for 52 years, whom he met on a blind date. Also survived by cousins, his favorite rugrats and ankle biters (nieces and nephews).

He worked at Span Master, Avon Lake, before retiring from Ford Motor. He was a very active member of the Amherst Veterans Military Honor Guard. 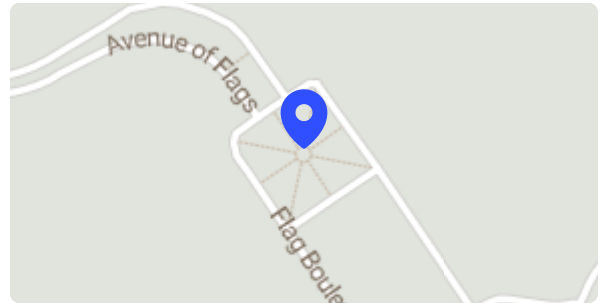

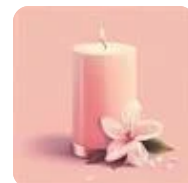
