Charlotte A. Eiden (née Stock), age 97, passed away peacefully on Monday, April 14, 2025, at Mercy New Life Hospice Center.

Born on March 5, 1928, in McKeesport, Pennsylvania, to Lawrence and Mildred (née Tolin) Stock, Charlotte moved to Lorain, Ohio, at the age of 19, working at Thew-Shovel and Bell Telephone Co., where she met John Eiden and raised her girls.

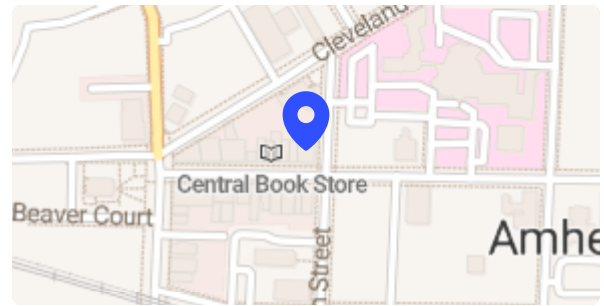

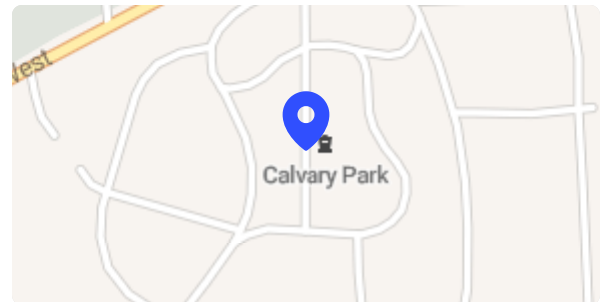
