Michael Schue, 73, of Amherst, passed away on Friday, August 8, 2025, doing what he loved most, fishing in his peaceful, happy place at the Amherst Outdoor Life Association.

Born September 7, 1951, in Lorain, Ohio, to James and Mercedes (née Kempt) Schue, Michael was a 1970 graduate of Lorain High School. He worked as a Stationary Engineer for Ohio Edison and Republic Steel, retiring in 2010.

A member of Mary Mother of God Catholic Church in Lorain, Michael found joy in the outdoors—whether golfing, fishing, or simply watching squirrels and the beauty of nature. 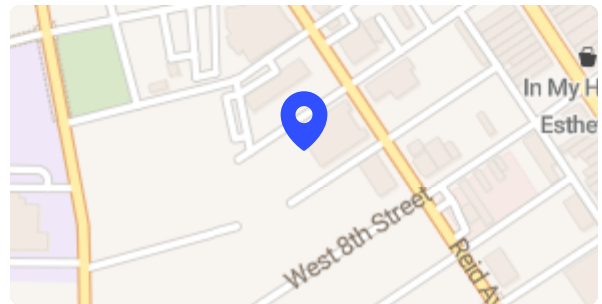

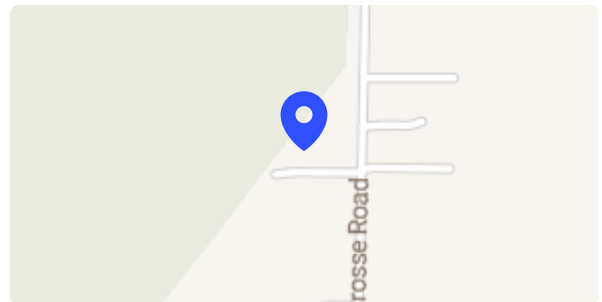
