In lieu of flowers, contributions may be made in John's honor to Mercy New Life Hospice by Compassus or Broadway Assembly Church.

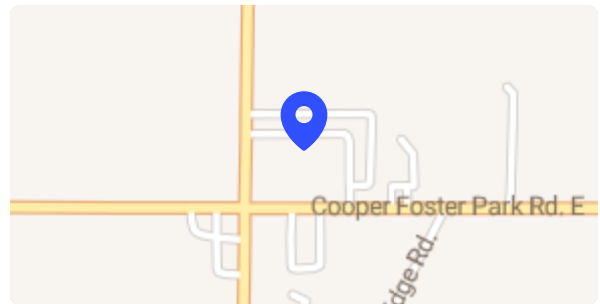

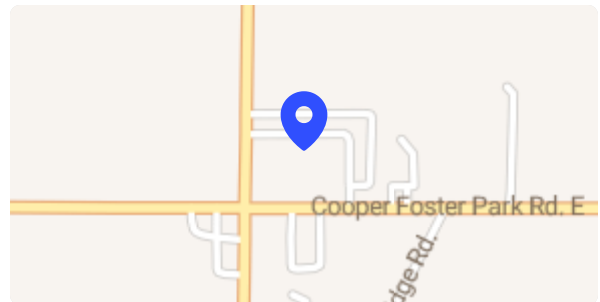

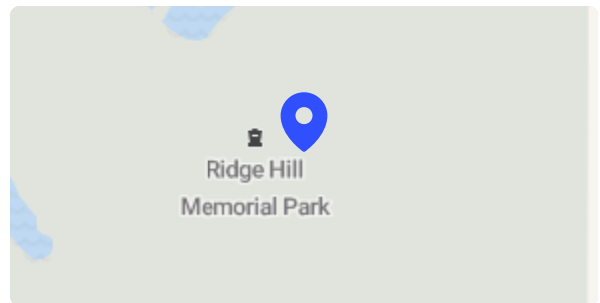
