**K**enneth Edward Williams, age 96, passed away peacefully on Thursday, April 23, 2026, at his home under the care of Crossroads Hospice.

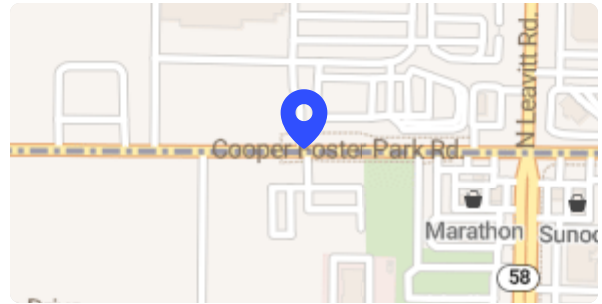

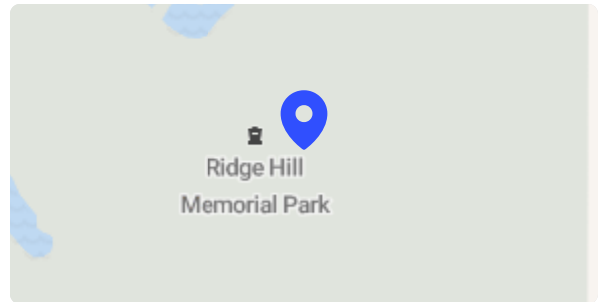
